Gather outdoors and grab an extra seat. Prop your feet—or your drink. Rainy day? Bring it inside, turn it around, and stash your umbrella. A new twist on outdoor furniture, **In The Loop** is a stool, table, pedestal, or umbrella stand.

The coil base was inspired by the graceful arcs of the curving vines found in the wetlands near designer Laura Spector's Connecticut home. Although the spiral shape may look unsteady, rest easy that it's a feat of nature in sturdy bent steel. "I take the grace of an organic form and combine it with the strength of metal," Spector explains, "And the result is elegant, yet whimsical and modern."

This 18" high garden gem weathers the elements in a range of jewel-toned colors, including South Beach Coral, fushia pink, tranqTeal, apple red, daffodil, blue skies and Snow white (custom colors also available.) Brighten the backyard with a circular top in copper or go green with recycled wood, or why choose? The replaceable tops come in 12" and 18" diameters.
